Dear all,

The day before yesterday, Jaco arrived in Pheriche (4240m) after a serious hike. He was able to take a shower and after a week without a shower this was a very welcome treat J. Yesterday was supposed to be a rest day but Russell decided to have them climb a peak – after two hours they reached the summit at 5045m.

Last night was Jaco's last night in a proper bed and from now on he will be sleeping in tents for the next 50 days or so. Unfortunately Jaco has been suffering for a couple of days now from a gastro (probably the same bug as I had) but apart from that he still feels strong. Especially for Ben & Allison and Sjak & Inge: Jaco brought lots of dices with him to play Snake Eyes and the team played it for the first time yesterday. Huge success!
